

# More Activities?

**There are simply too many things to list!  
(But here are a few ideas...)**

- **Mission Impossible (M.I.)**
- This is most likely what most students will be begging to do in the evening! The Coordinator will show the boundaries and demonstrate the game during daylight hours so when evening comes there will be less chance of confusion... Custom rules apply to the game to keep everyone safe and the game fair!
- **Scavenger Hunts**
- We have several options for searching through the wilds around the facility! Specific 'Hunts' can be found on the 'Resources' page found on this website or feel free to come up with your own to meet your class' needs!
- **Fire Lighting**
- Students are taught the basics of making a fire safely then, in teams, participate in a race to see who can boil a 'Billie Can' half full of water first!
- **'Plain Sight'**
- A 'flag' is placed in plain view in front of the cookhouse and teams, (usually one dorm vs. the other,) try to steal it and put it in a designated spot! This game runs all day and the team that takes it the most time wins! The coordinator will make the rules very clear, and the game will not interrupt class time.
- **Field Games**
- We like to encourage as much play as possible at the facility so please feel free to bring outdoor P.E. equipment so we can go have some fun! (Crab soccer and California kickball are always popular no matter what age!)
