Bear/Fox – animals fur changing (thickness, color)

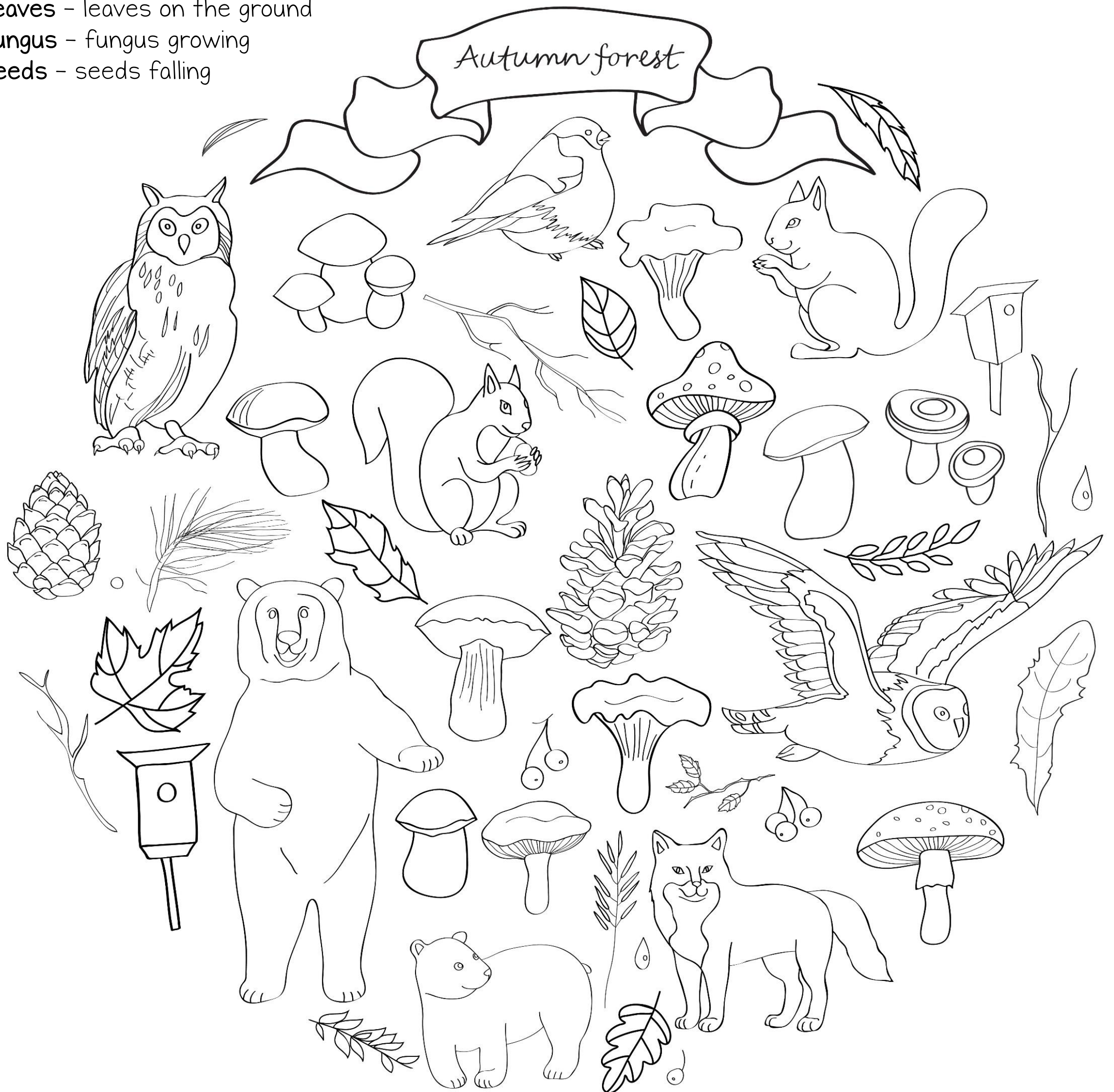
Birds – geese flying in a V-shape

Seeds – seeds falling



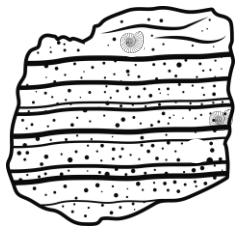

Directions: Mark each circle and draw evidence of any of the following rock features:



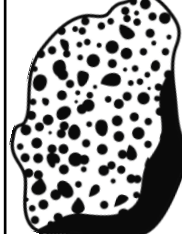
Sedimentary Rock

Small pieces of sand, shells, pebbles and other material form together in layers.



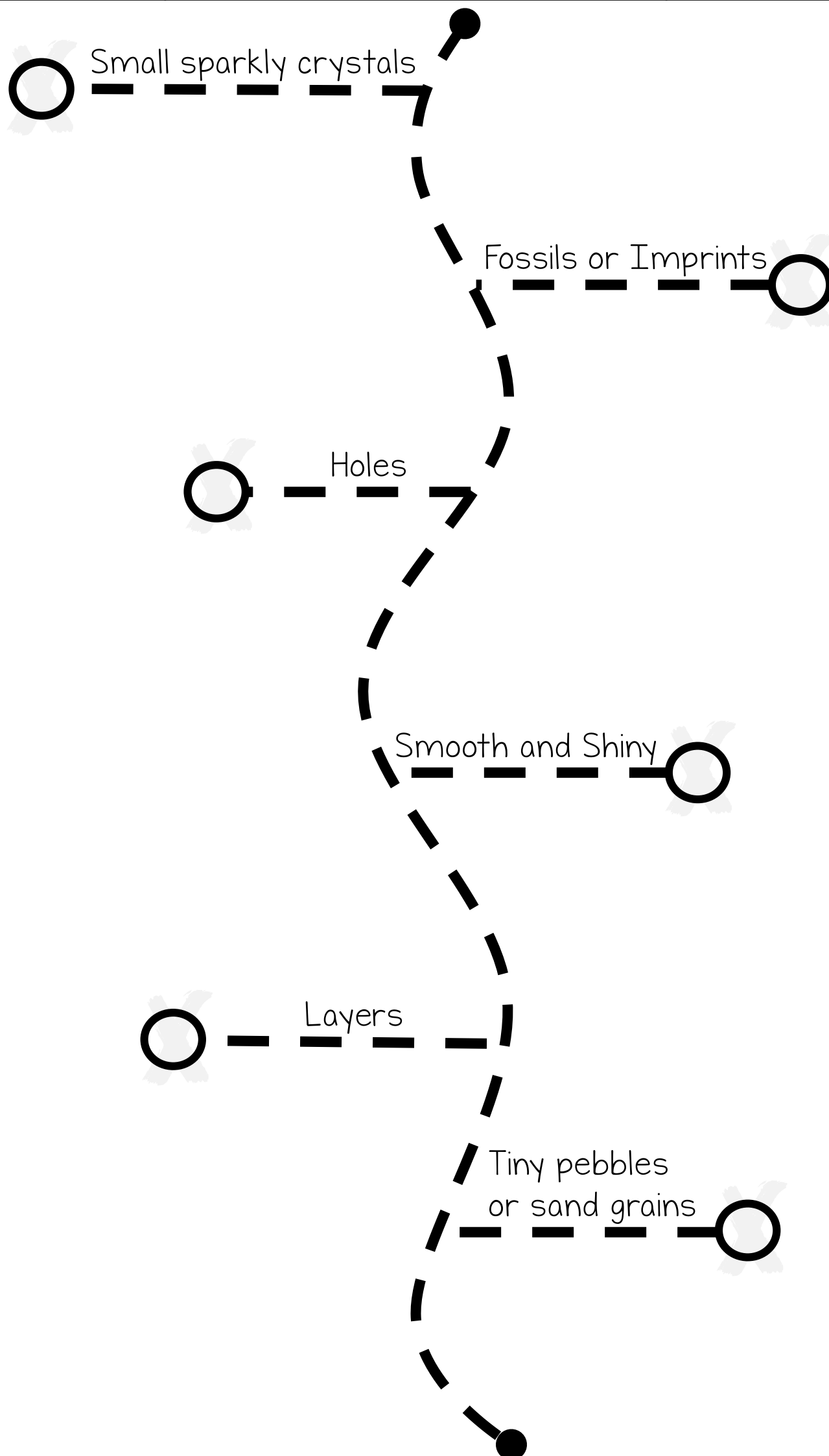
Metamorphic Rock

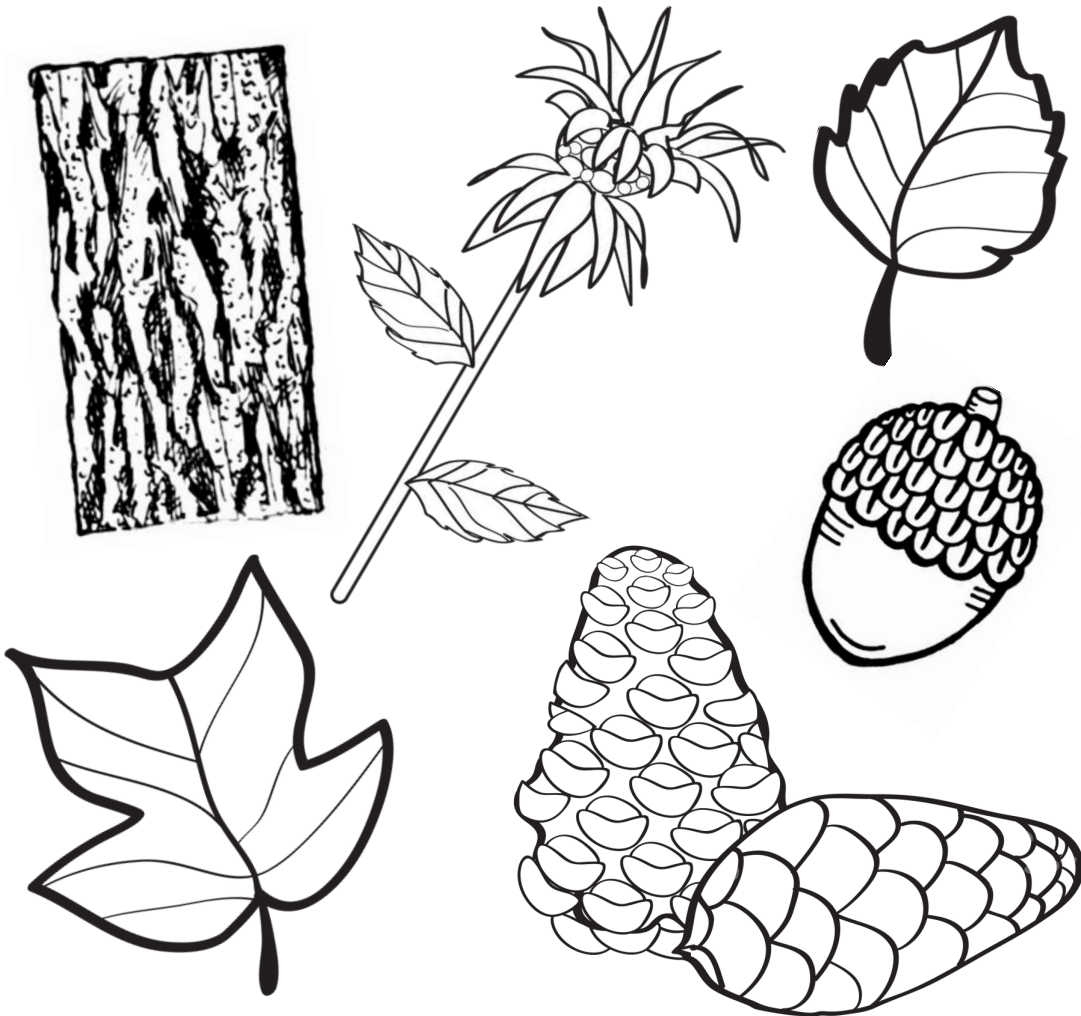

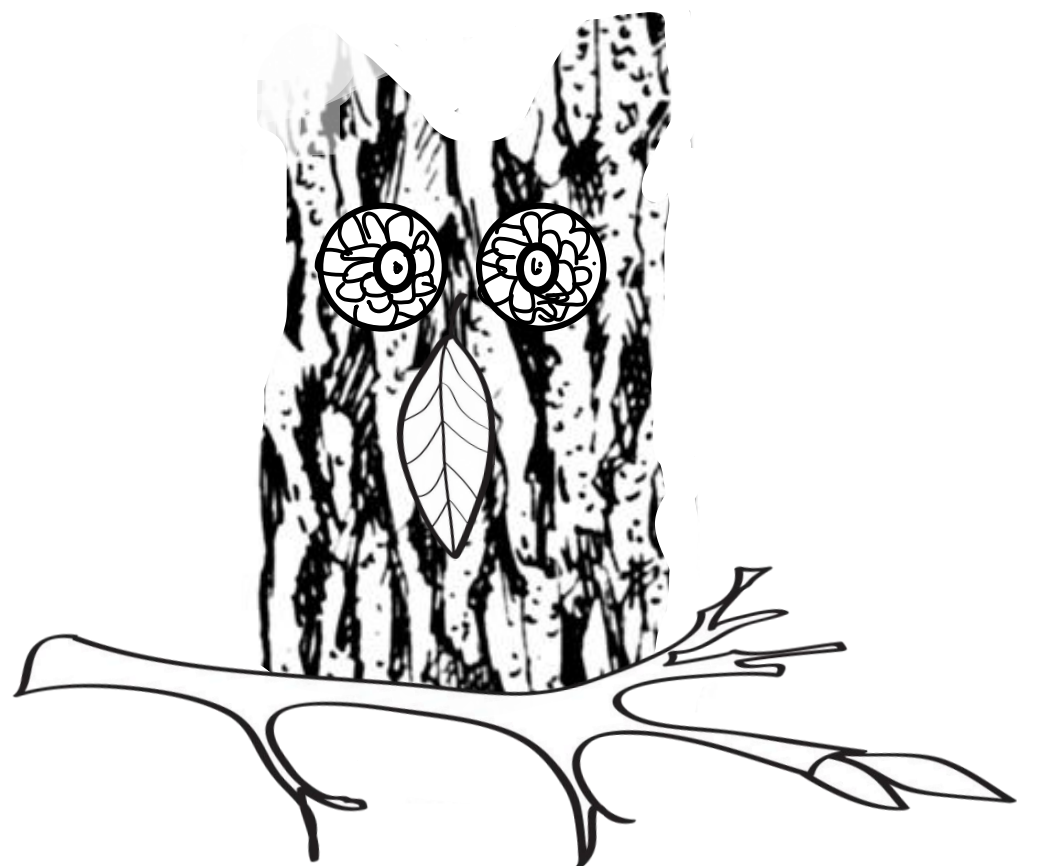
Woodland Creature

- 2 Arrange your collected items to form your creature. Use the items you collected as inspiration, look at the shapes and textures.



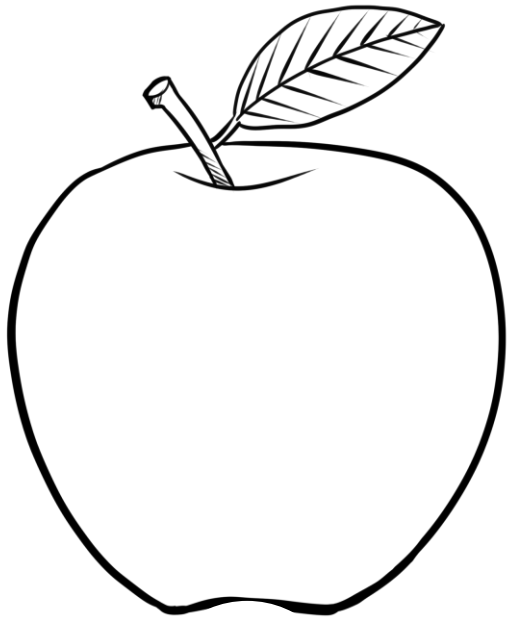
- 3 Write a short story about your woodland creature, be sure to include fun facts like where your creature lives and what he/she eats.

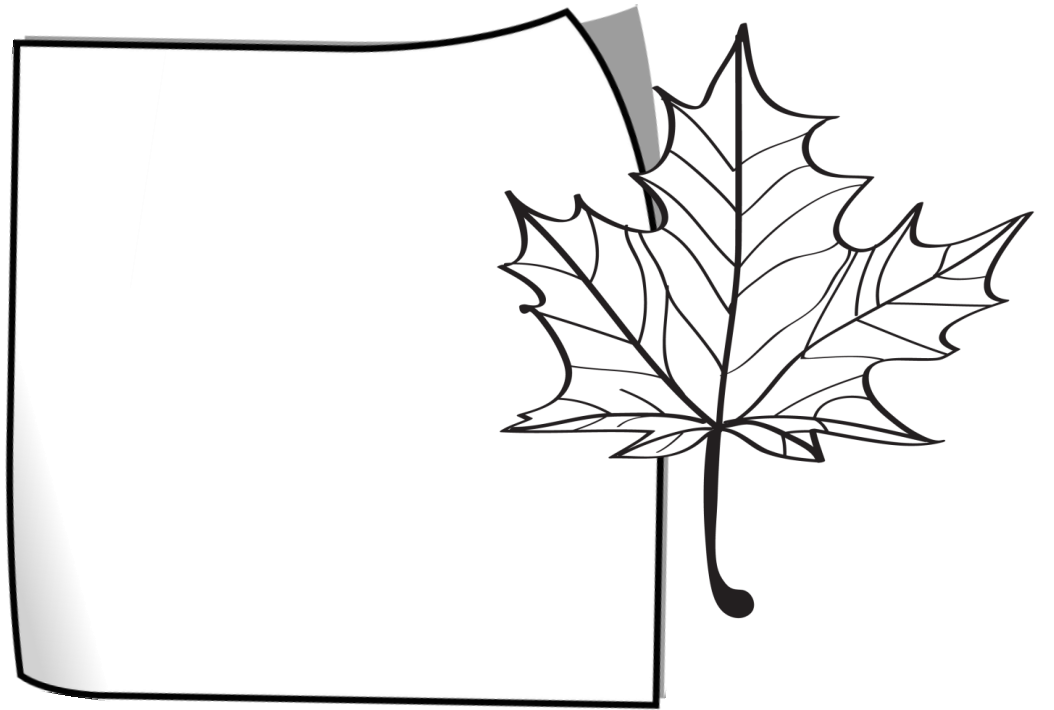
Illustrate Leaf Rubbings

Directions: Follow the steps to create a leaf rubbing.

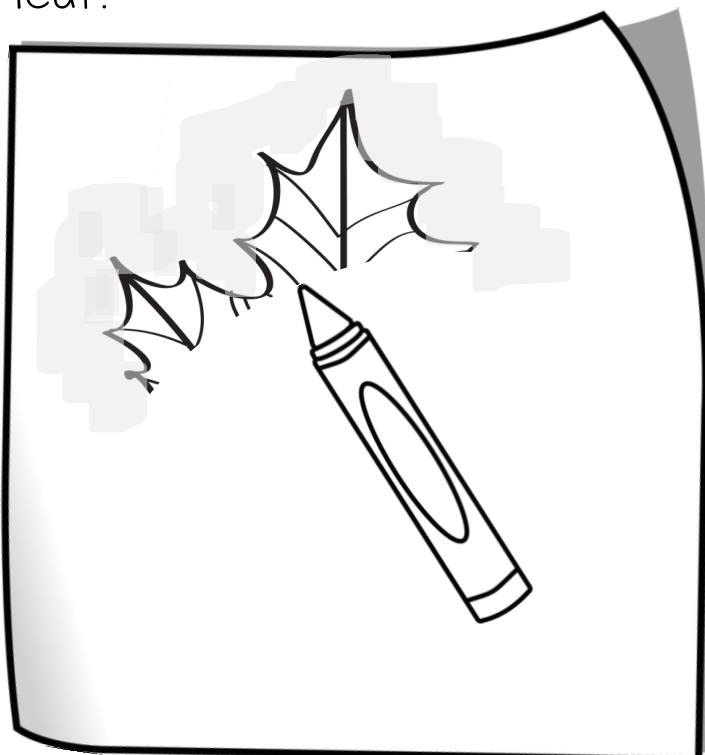
- 1** You will need the following supplies:
Paper (or use the back of this page)
Crayons: broken without the wrapper work best
Assortment of leaves



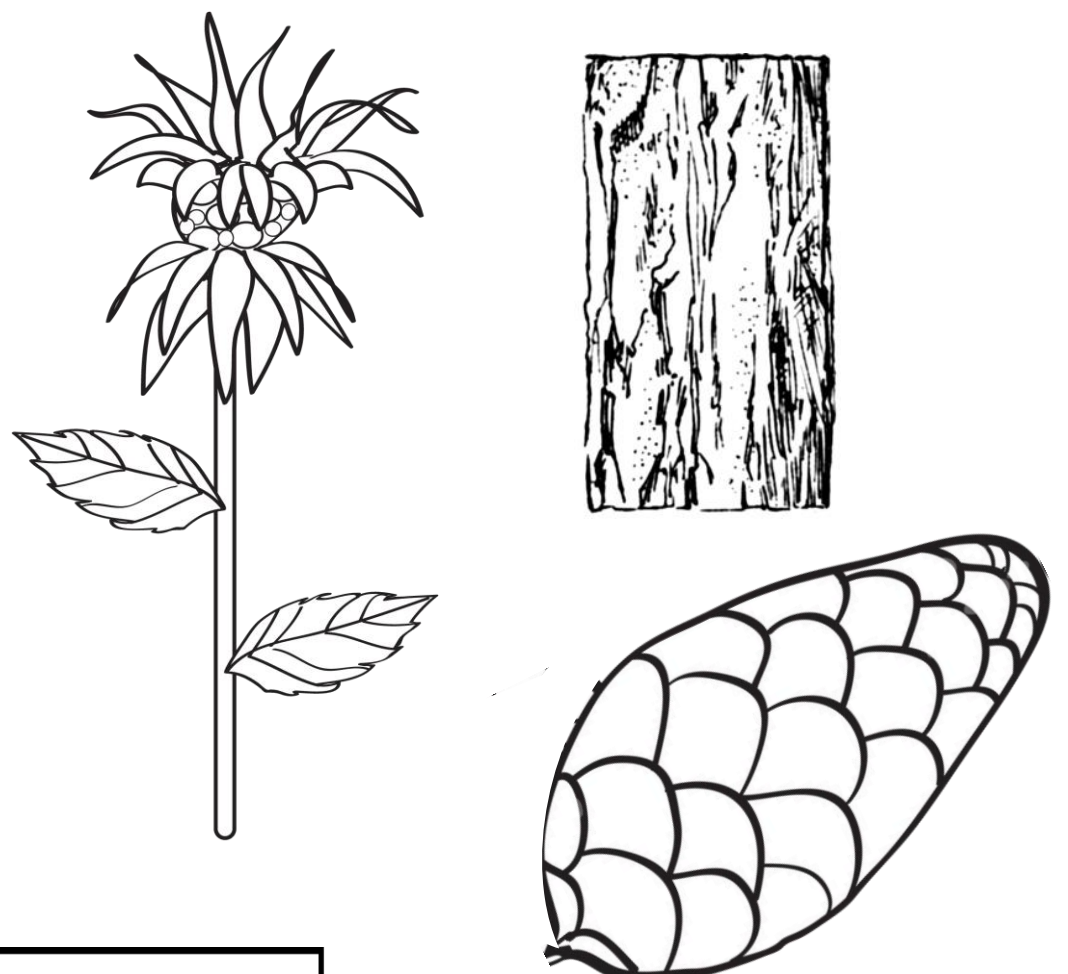
- 2** Place a leaf under the paper. Ask an adult for help holding the paper down on a solid surface. You could also tape the corners down to prevent the paper from shifting.



- 3** With the leaf underneath your paper rub over it using the side of your crayon. Apply varying amounts of pressure to capture the complete leaf.



- 4** Explore other items found in nature that you could do a rubbing of: tree bark, flower, pinecone...

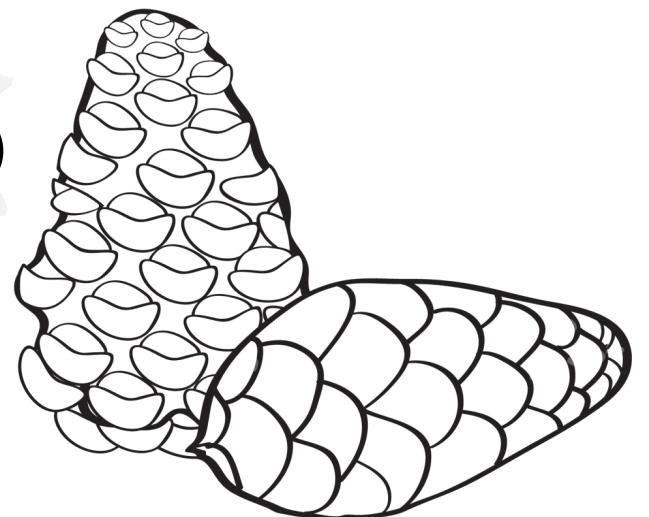
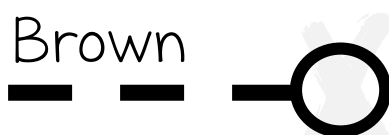
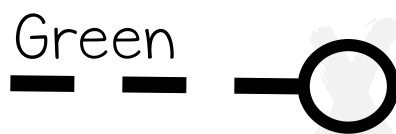
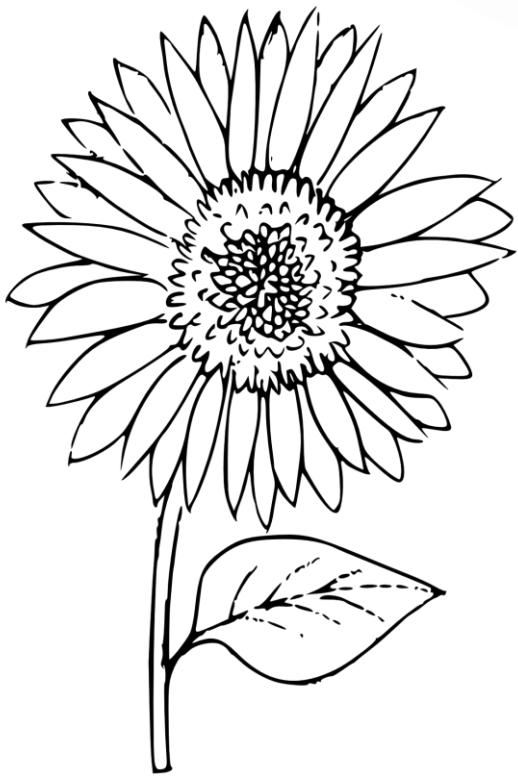
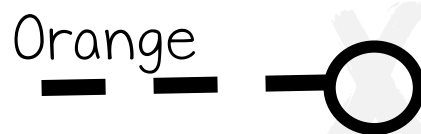
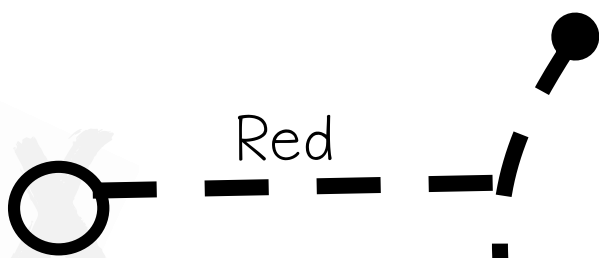

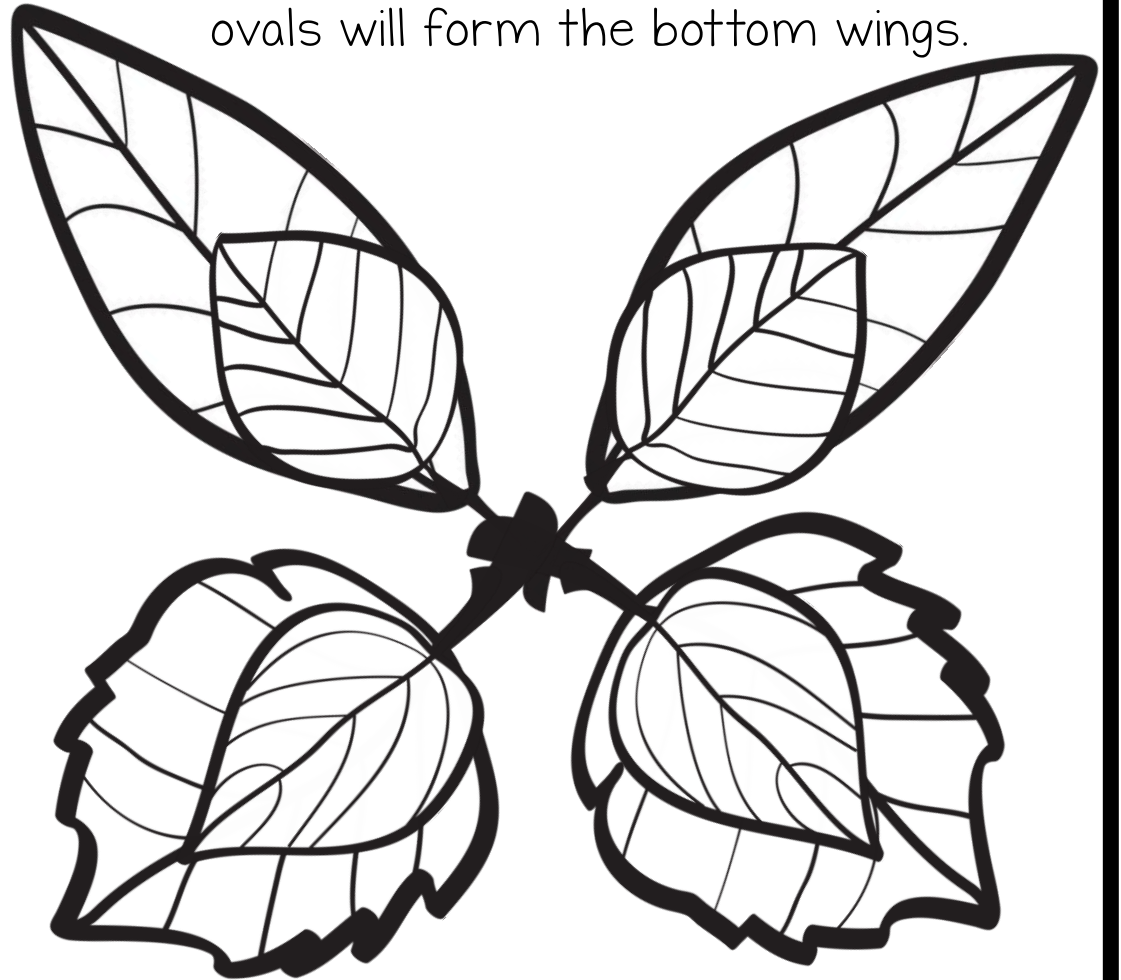


Supplies:

- 2 Small berries
- 2 large oval leaves
- 2 medium oval leaves
- 2 small round leaves
- 2 small leaves rounded with a point
- (Leaf pairs should be similar in size and shape)
- 1 Twig for the body

Place the matching leaves across from one another. The large ovals will form the top wings and the medium ovals will form the bottom wings.

Use the stick to form the body. Next, add the berries on top of leaf stems to form the antenna.

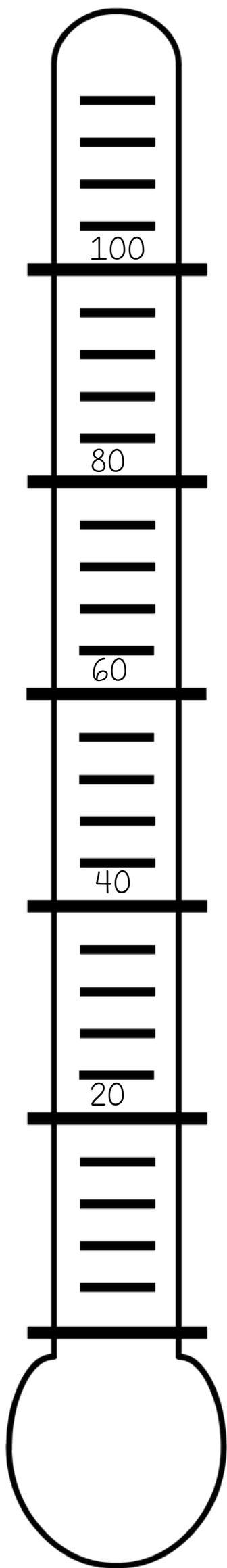

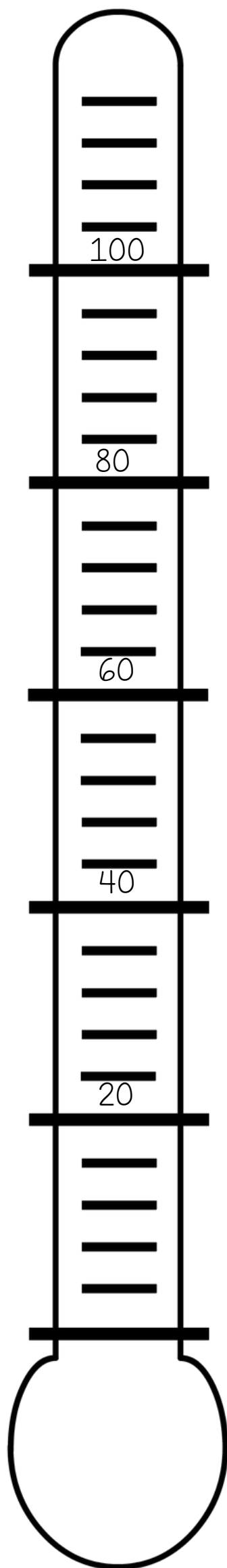

Temperature Tracker

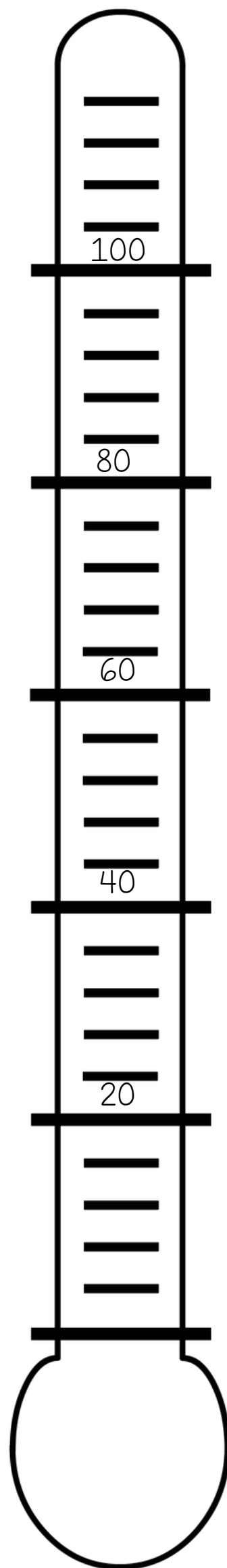

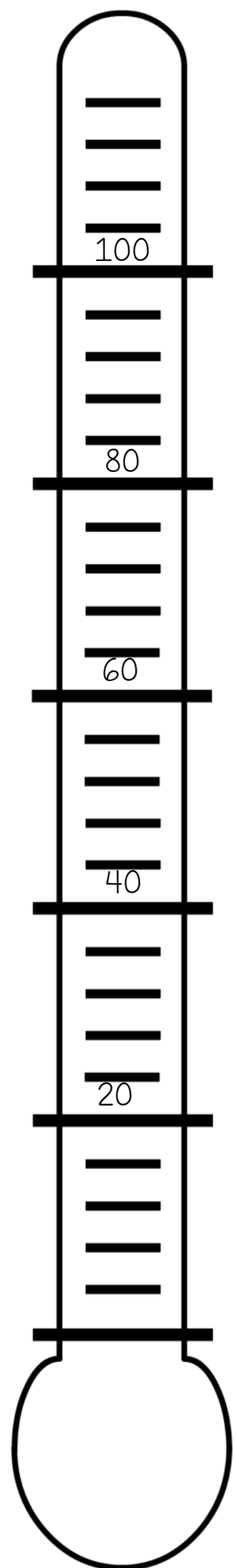

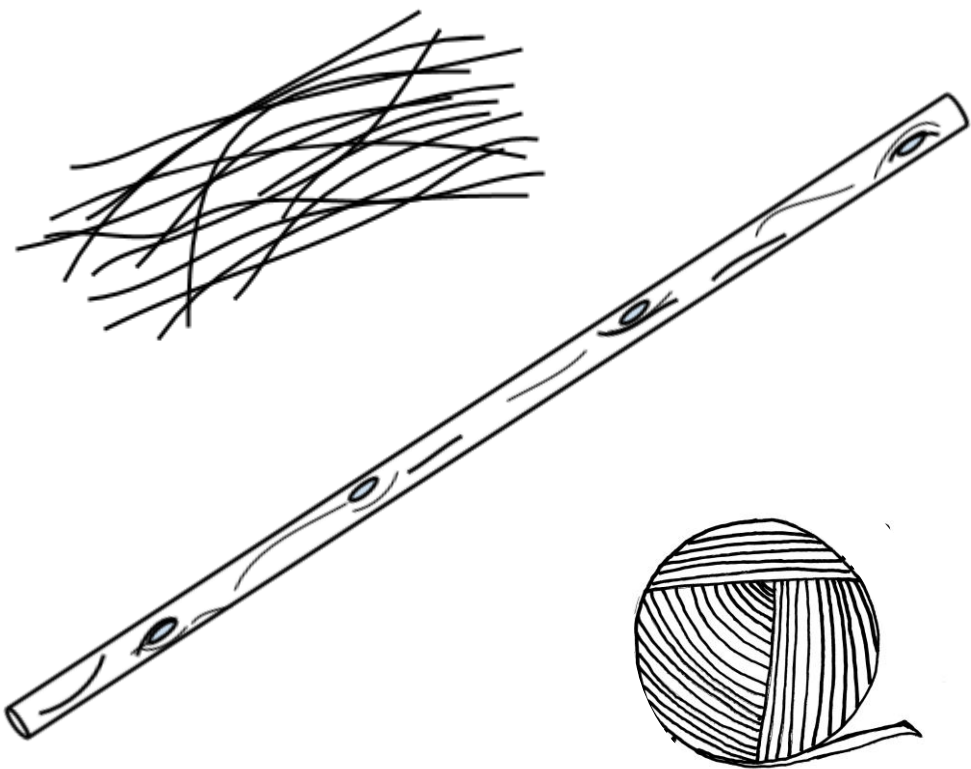

Design and Build Witch's Broomstick
